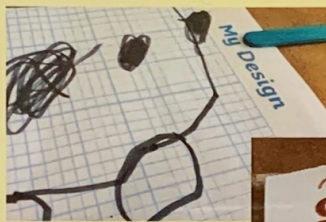

Finley said, "I created my music using a metal drum and it was quite low pitched."

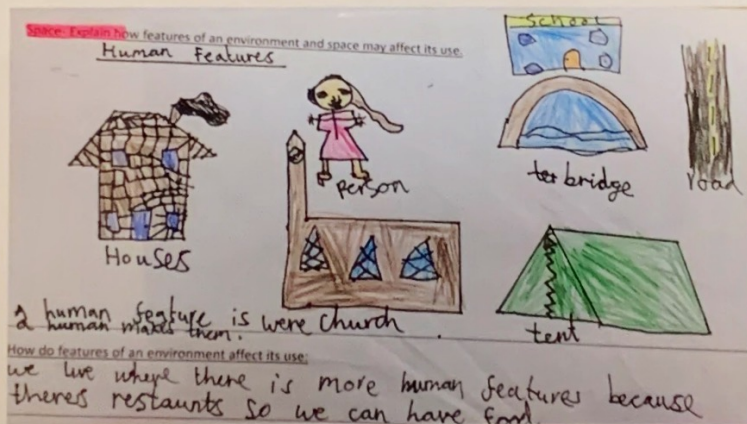

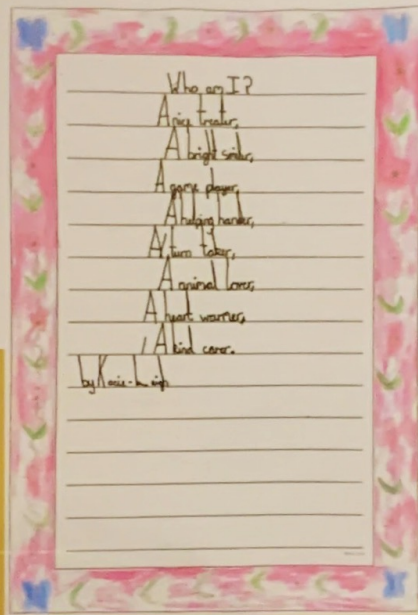
Charlotte Evans (Y3)

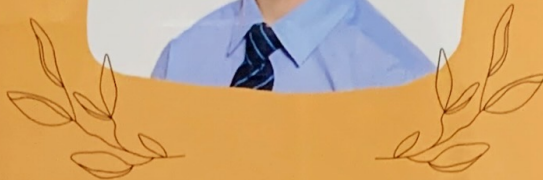
PSHE - ETHIC OF EXCELLENCE

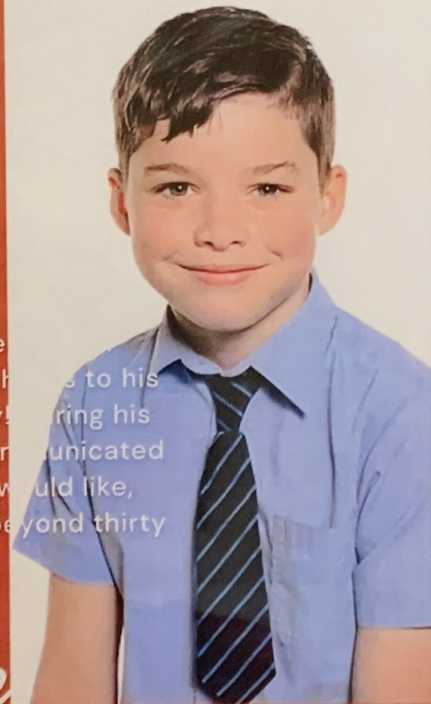


Dylan thought deeply and carefully about how he could practise his use of colour. He showed a wonderful understanding of tessellation and monochromatic colours.

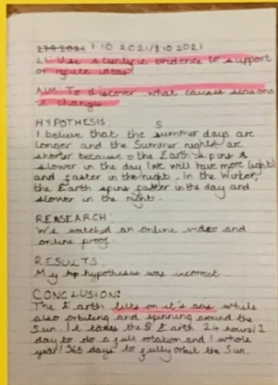
