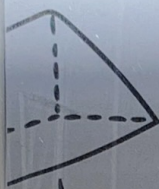


Esme has made excellent progress in her Maths learning during this term. She has excelled in her confidence and is now completing her challenges independently, moving onto Challenge C most days!

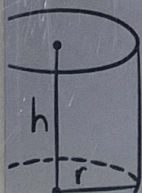
