## Re: Y6 Bubble Closure

I have been notified today that a member of the Y6 bubble has tested positive for Covid-19. This has been confirmed by a PCR test. A further member of the bubble has tested positive using a lateral flow test and has been advised to book a PCR test.

As a result, the Year 6 bubble will be closed from today (12.7.21) and will reopen on Monday 19 July. Children should self-isolate but there is no need for other family members to do so, meaning siblings in other year groups can still attend school. However please avoid bringing any Year 6 pupils to school when dropping or collecting siblings.

I know that this is devastating for the children as they were due to have their performance and last Sports Day this week. We're so disappointed for them. This week, children should access our remote learning offer: Mrs Turner will be in touch via dojo to arrange this. We will also do our best to arrange an alternative way to share their performance.

Please also see the additional letter regarding self-isolation timescales.

I realise that this will cause inconvenience to many of you – please accept my sincere apologies.
