Re: Closure Arrangements

Following the announcement this evening, I can confirm that, from tomorrow morning, the school is closed to all pupils apart from:

- the children of parents who previously were offered provision because of their critical worker status, unless their employment has since changed, or
- children who were previously considered to be vulnerable are also able to attend.

If you consider yourself to be a critical worker now, but were not during the previous lockdown, please contact us in the morning via email and include a completed copy of the application form which can be found on our website here: <https://www.stmarymagdaleneprimary.co.uk/covid-19-response/>.

Please note that employment status checks that were necessary during the previous school closures will also be necessary this time. Therefore, if possible, please also include a copy of any correspondence from your employer. However, with such little notice, we are keen to ensure the continuity of provision for all children of parents who consider themselves to be critical workers.

Any parents who consider their child to be vulnerable, but who were not during the previous lockdown, please make contact with school tomorrow.
