










# Night



<p><b>1</b> Teach</p>	<p> Use a <u>sign</u> or <u>gesture</u> for <b>night</b>.</p> <p> Look at the <u>symbol</u> together.</p> <p> <u>Say</u> the word <b>night</b> to your partner.</p> <p> <u>Sing</u> a Word Aware song including the word <b>night</b>.</p>
<p><b>2</b> Teach</p> 	<p><b>Equipment: Concept Cat toy, a toy bed, pictures of a moon, stars and fireworks.</b></p> <p>Concept Cat is a clever, clever cat. He looks here, he looks there, learning as he goes and, when he comes home, he tells us a story. Concept Cat is a clever, clever cat. This story is all about <b>night</b>. Listen out for the word <b>night</b>.</p> <p>Concept Cat was awake at <b>night</b> time. He looked at the <b>night</b> sky. It was <b>night</b>, so Concept Cat could see the stars. It was <b>night</b>, so Concept Cat could see the Moon. It was <b>night</b>, so Concept Cat could see some fireworks.</p> <p>Mum came in and said, 'Because it is <b>night</b>, Concept Cat, you should be in bed and because it is <b>night</b> you should be asleep. Good <b>night</b> Concept Cat,' said Mum.</p> <p>Concept Cat, what a clever, clever cat. He knows all about <b>night</b>.</p>
<p><b>3</b> Teach</p>	<p>A Ask the children to pretend to go to sleep because it is <b>night</b>-time.</p> <p>B Talk about bedtime routines using the word <b>night</b>.</p>
<p><b>4</b> Activate</p>	<p>A In the home corner, put teddy bears to bed because it is <b>night</b> time.</p> <p>B Read a book about bedtime. Talk about it, using the word <b>night</b>.</p>
<p><b>5</b> Review</p>	<p> <b>Activity:</b> look at pictures of day and <b>night</b> and talk about them, using the words <b>night</b> and <u>not</u> <b>night</b>.</p> <p> <b>Word Bag:</b> put a toy pillow in the bag and talk about going to bed at <b>night</b>.</p> <p> <b>Concept book:</b> see page 76 for details.</p> <p> <b>Family:</b> look out of the window at <b>night</b> time. Talk about having no sunshine at <b>night</b> time. Read a book that ends with 'good <b>night</b>'.</p>
