Dear Parents and Carers,

Re. Pupil Leadership

As it is the beginning of the new school year, it is also the opportunity for your child to become involved in a number of pupil leadership roles across school. Class teachers will share these with the children in class, but we would also love your involvement in helping them with the application process. Even if your child had a leadership role previously, they will still need to re-apply this year, this is to ensure that all children who would like a leadership role have the opportunity to do so. The closing date for applications is **9:00 Friday 18th September**, please hand applications to class teachers. Application forms can be requested from the school office and class teachers. The children will need to state which role they are applying for within their application form, they can apply for more than one role but separate application forms will need completing.

Here are the roles and how to apply:

Vacancy	How to Apply
School Councillors – this is open for applications from Y1 – Y6	Children should prepare a short presentation to present to their class. Their class members will then vote for their councillors. They should consider: The school values and how they demonstrate these One aspect of the school that they feel is excellent One aspect of the school they would like to improve, and ideas for how to do this.
KS2 Worship Leaders - this is open for applications from Y3 – Y6 Y6 Senior Worship Leaders - this is open for applications from Y6 only, and only if they have been a worship leader previously.	Children should submit a written application in which they write about: Our school's Christian vision and how they live this out Why faith/spirituality is important in their lives How they can help to strengthen worship at St Mary's.
New Faith in Action - this is open for applications from Key Stage 2	Children should submit a written application in which they write about: Our school's Christian Vision and how they live this out How they will be courageous advocated within the community Explain what their passions for change are. <i>This role is to build upon the introduction of the group last year. The children will help to fight social injustice within the local community - giving a voice to the voiceless, organising fundraising events and offering support within the local community to strengthen the work already undertaken by the Church.</i>
KS2 Reading Champions - this is open for applications from Y3 – Y6.	Children should submit a written application in which they write about: Why they feel they would be a good reading champion How they meet the person specification Their favourite author, and why
