










Loud



<p>1 Teach</p>	<p> Use a <u>sign</u> or <u>gesture</u> for loud.</p> <p> Look at the <u>symbol</u> together.</p> <p> <u>Say</u> the word loud to your partner.</p> <p> <u>Sing</u> a Word Aware song including the word loud.</p>
<p>2 Teach</p> 	<p>Equipment: Concept Cat toy and a drum.</p> <p>Concept Cat is a clever, clever cat. He looks here, he looks there, learning as he goes and, when he comes home, he tells us a story. Concept Cat is a clever, clever cat. This story is all about loud. Listen out for the word loud.</p> <p>One day, Concept Cat was trying to sleep. He was very tired. Then he heard a loud noise (bang on the drum). 'Oh, that is so loud! I will try to sleep again.' Then Concept Cat heard a loud noise (stamp feet loudly). 'Oh, what a loud noise! I just want to sleep.' Then he heard some loud talking (say 'Hello' loudly). 'Oh, that is very loud! It is very hard to sleep with all these loud noises. I need you to help me to sleep.'</p> <p>Do <u>not</u> make loud noises. Do <u>not</u> be loud. (Ensure that the children are <u>not</u> loud.)</p> <p>Now let's play a trick on Concept Cat. Let's all make lots of loud noises. We can all stamp, bang and say 'Hello' all at the same time</p> <p>Concept Cat: Oh no, that is so loud!</p> <p>Concept Cat, what a clever, clever cat. He knows all about loud.</p>
<p>3 Teach</p>	<p>A Let's clap loudly. Now let's clap <u>not loudly</u>. Now clap loudly again.</p> <p>B Let's talk loudly. Now let's talk <u>not loudly</u>. Now talk loudly again.</p> <p>C Let's walk loudly. (Stamp feet.) Now let's walk <u>not loudly</u>. (Walk on tiptoes.) Now walk loudly again.</p>
<p>4 Activate</p>	<p>Play musical instruments. Play them loud and <u>not loud</u>.</p>
<p>5 Review</p>	<p> Activity: talk about a time when you heard something loud.</p> <p> Word Bag: put a bell in the bag. Make a loud sound.</p> <p> Concept book: see page 76 for details.</p> <p> Family: see how loudly you can talk when you are going home.</p>
